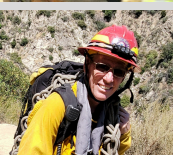
FIRE MARSHAL

Rich served on several State and local Code committees including California's Chapter 7A Standard (now known as CWUIC Title 24 Part 7) for Materials and Construction Methods for Exterior Wildfire Exposure.
